GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING IN EXTENSION

The Graduate Certificate in Teaching in Extension provides training to non-extension personnel on the purposes, history, structure, function, and development of extension education programs. Students pursing this certificate receive fundamental training on how to deliver effective instruction in a variety of settings across multiple age groups. The coursework for this certificate includes principles of extension, delivery of extension, and advanced teaching methods for extension, plus an elective course. This certificate could be applied in a variety of different graduate programs that provide breadth and expertise in the latest programmatic offerings and opportunities in extension.
