

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN STUDENT AFFAIRS ADMINISTRATION

*This certificate may have courses in common with other graduate certificates. A student may earn more than one certificate, but a given course may be counted only in one certificate.



Develop the skills and knowledge needed to design programs to help students' learning and development potential in their college experiences. This certificate is designed to help students become competent practitioners with an understanding of:

1. How and why students develop during postsecondary years
2. Historical and philosophical foundations of student affairs
3. Relationships between college students and their social/physical environments
4. Higher education's finance environment

This four-course, 11-credit program requires a completed bachelor's degree and a 3.000 grade point average.
