## CERTIFICATE IN VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES

Vector-borne and zoonotic diseases continue to emerge and reemerge, threatening human and animal health. This comprehensive certificate program in Vector-Borne Diseases (VBD) aims to provide CSU undergraduate students with a solid foundation in vector-borne diseases, equipping them with the knowledge and skills in this disciplinary area for careers in fields such as public health, vector control, and epidemiology.

- 1. Examine the role of arthropods in the spread of emerging vectorborne pathogens, including the transmission cycles of prominent vector-borne diseases, and how vector physiology and host-pathogen interaction contribute to pathogen transmission.
